Membership:

- Full Individual Members** of the NFA need to
- have been resident within a 50 mile radius of Findhorn and involved in the Community for a minimum period of 6 months (This can be cumulative over the last 2 years).
 - be at least 13 years old
 - be willing to support the NFA and abide by its constitution and policies
 - commit to the Statement of Common Ground
 - be current in the payment of the membership fee
- Only Full Members are entitled to vote at any meeting

Subscription:

(a) Full individual members

The NFA needs an average of £100 per member to cover the running costs. In view of the varied resources of members of the Community we are asking people to **attune** to how much they personally can contribute. Payment by Standing Order for monthly payments makes our planning easier. Open ended Standing Orders will make membership renewals easier in future years. Children under 13 are free. Subscription for 13-18 year olds is £20 per teenager. Member Organisations can pay the membership subscriptions for their staff.

(b) Temporary Members

People who are going to be in the area for a period of **six months or less** and would like to contribute to the Community can become **non-voting temporary members**. Guideline figure around £10 per month. You can apply for full membership at the end of six months, paying the remaining amount for full annual subscription.

(c) Associate Members

People who live outside the area, but are significantly involved with this Community (eg. Trustees, ex-members, Friends and Stewards of the Foundation) can become **non-voting associate members**. Guideline figure £50.
